


## Tad/Toro

The Tad/Toro Property covers 6,474 hectares of prospective ground along the Big Creek Fault in the Dawson Range, Yukon. The Property is underlain by Paleozoic Metamorphics (YTT) and Cretaceous Intrusions.

The Property covers four mineral occurrences. Mineralization consists of disseminated pyrite, sphalerite, galena, and arsenopyrite bearing quartz veins along shear zones.



## **Big Creek**

The Big Creek Property covers 5,100 hectares of prospective ground along the Big Creek Fault in the Dawson Range, Yukon. The Property is underlain by Paleozoic Metamorphics (YTT), Jurassic intrusions and Cretaceous intrusions.

Mineralization on the Property has mostly been identified through soil geochemistry with anomalous copper silver, and arsenic along the southeast and northwest ends of the Big Creek Fault. The Property was acquired from Teck Resources Limited in 2021 and is contiguous with the Tad/Toro Property.
